- c) Certificates to be produced prior to unloading.
- d) Entries and number of sheep to be advised to Stewards at least 36 hours prior to show to assist penning arrangements.
- e) All sheep must be penned and ready for judging by 9am on Saturday of show.
- f) Sheep for pen groups may be chosen from any single entry.
- g) Shearing date must be supplied with all entries and shall be made available to the judges.
- All exhibits to be deemed worthy of first or second prize in the opinion of the judge, otherwise no prize will be awarded. Exhibitor to make declaration of age if required by the steward.
- i) The Society's definition of the condition, 'bred and owned by exhibitor', in this section shall be that the exhibitor must be responsible for the mating of the sire and dam.

The Chief Steward and/or their nominees shall exclude from any unhoused classes any exhibit which they consider is ineligible through having been improperly treated, housed, singed, or clipped and shall refer such exhibit entry to the Judge prior to it being presented for judging.
